

The Health and Safety of our contestants, partners, and employees is our top priority

Keurig Dr Pepper (KDP) will follow all relevant Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), State, and Local requirements/guidelines for the Dr Pepper 2020 Tuition Giveaway event. KDP will collaborate with Health Officials and third-party experts as required to ensure state-of-the-art health precautions are adhered to.

A detailed Health and Safety Plan will be provided for the event and event contestants outlining preventative measures for travel/lodging, public spaces, organized event activities, film production, and other related activities. The Health and Safety Plan will be developed in collaboration with other parties having a physical presence at the event and may be adjusted over time if relevant guidance or requirements change.

Health and Safety Plan elements will include but are not limited to:

- **Health Screenings:** Health screening will be required for contestants and any other people who may be in proximity to contestants during the event. Health screening may include testing for COVID-19 active infection.
- **Mandatory Social Distancing:** Strict social distancing protocols will be required during all event activities. Some television production activities may require special precautions following relevant industry guidelines.
- **PPE and Hygiene:** Face masks/coverings will be required during all event activities except under specific circumstances where additional precautions are met. Hand washing/sanitizing will be required along with other hygiene requirements. PPE such as face shields and disposable gloves may also be specified when needed.
- **Enhanced Cleaning Protocols:** Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing procedures will be in place in accordance with CDC guidance. Contestants will be responsible for sanitizing personal objects and surfaces in public spaces – specific guidance will be provided.
- **Segmentation:** Segmentation (otherwise known as “cohorting”) concepts will be applied to people involved with the event to minimize risk to contestants and other parties. The use of common areas will be restricted/prescribed as will staging or “green room” locations. Protocols for safe food and beverage consumption will also be in place.
- **Site Control:** Private event locations will be access-controlled; only authorized personnel will be allowed on-site. Visitors will be prohibited unless authorized, and protocols will be in place to manage risks associated with deliveries and other such activities.
- **COVID Case Management:** Case Management protocols will be in place to quickly respond to contact with or exposure to confirmed cases of COVID-19. Protocols include reporting, investigation (contact tracing), isolation or quarantine, collaboration with Health Officials, and communication to affected parties/individuals.
